# Are you a domestic well owner in the Butte Valley?

## Is your well dry, or not in good working condition?

## Here is how we may be able to help!

Drought conditions across California have led to falling water levels, drying domestic wells and households without water. The City of Dorris and Butte Valley Irrigation District (BVID) have obtained grant funding to assist with rehabilitation and repairs needed if your domestic well has been affected **Please complete and return this brief** <u>Well Survey</u> in the included self-addressed stamped envelope to both provide information on your well and identify yourself as a potential candidate for water well rehabilitation. This questionnaire is a crucial step in assessing water needs in the Butte Valley and working to help residents regain access to drinking water.

Actions to be taken based on the responses we receive include:

#### Water well assessment or replacement:

- We will inspect the health of your well for free.
- If your well is dry or failing, you may be considered as a candidate for funded drinking water well rehabilitation, deepening, or replacement.

#### Emergency access to hauled water or bottled water:

• We may be able to help you by arranging for water to be delivered to your house for free.

#### Information about this project:

The Butte Valley Emergency Drought Relief Project is a multi-year effort to improve drought resiliency through a well deepening and water delivery program in the Butte Valley Watershed. This is a California Department of Water Resources funded project that seeks to benefit community members of the Butte Valley Watershed impacted by ongoing drought conditions.
